Application to An Bord Pleanála

1. Eoin Sheehan, intend to apply to An Bord Pleanála for permission for a strategic housing development at this site at Monacappa, Blarney, Cork. The proposed development will consist of a strategic housing development of 143no. residential units (9no. 1-bed, 38no. 2-bed, 71no. 3-bed, and 26no. 4-bed units), comprising 103no. houses (3no. detached, 42no. semi-detached, and 60no. terraced units) and 38no. apartments, ranging in height from 2-3 storeys above ground, including split-level houses.
